Scholarship Application Guidelines

1. Mail the completed form, with any additional information included on a separate attached pages, to **CITA/PO Box 26471/Greenville, SC/29616 Attn: Student Scholarship**. If you have any questions about the application email Bryanne Barker at admin@cita.org

2. Scholarships will provide all on-site conference expenses: meals, lodging (quad occupancy), registration fee, and 1-year CITA membership. **Travel is not included.**

3. Application deadline: **Applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2008.** Applications will not be accepted after this date. Email applications are not acceptable.

4. **Recipients must provide travel to and from the conference site, including ground transportation to and from the airport if applicable.**

5. Scholarship recipients will receive their expenses paid at the time of the conference and not in advance.

6. Applicants should request two letters of reference from the following: **one should be from a current teacher who will attest to your eligibility and need for the scholarship funds. One should be from a pastor or other non-relative who can comment on your potential for future accomplishment in the theatre arts.**

7. **Letters of reference should be mailed directly to the CITA address above by the writers, and not by the student applicant.** Please mention the applicant's name prominently in the letter or on the envelope. **No email recommendations will be accepted.**

8. Scholarships will be granted on the basis of need, potential for future growth, career goals, and timeliness of application.

9. Applicants must be full time students at the time of application.
